11 Historic District commonly known as the Medicine Bow intermediate
12 field located on state land near Medicine Bow. This appropriation
13 shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose. It is
14 the intent of the legislature that this appropriation not be
15 included in the department of state parks and cultural resources'
16 standard budget for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.

18 4. Of this other funds appropriation, two hundred thousand
19 dollars (\$200,000.00)S0 is from the Wyoming tourism account for
20 archeological testing and validation on the Wiggins Fork bison
21 jumps complex. This appropriation shall not be transferred or
22 expended for any other purpose. It is the intent of the legislature
23 that this appropriation not be included in the department of state
24 parks and cultural resources' standard budget for the immediately
25 succeeding fiscal biennium.

27 5. Of this general fund appropriation, thirty-five thousand
28 dollars (\$35,000.00) is appropriated for the purpose of
29 retrieving, developing and curating a display for the 1893
30 Yellowstone Forest Reserve Survey Party Tree Inscription from the
31 Shoshone National Forest. This appropriation shall not be
32 transferred or expended for any other purpose. It is the intent of
33 the legislature that this appropriation shall not be included in
34 the department of state parks and cultural resources' standard
35 budget for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium."
