A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; amending the
2 offense of interference with a peace officer by creating an
3 additional felony offense; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-5-204(b) is amended to read:

9

10 **6-5-204. Interference with peace officer; disarming**
11 **peace officer; penalties.**

13 (b) A person who intentionally and knowingly causes
14 or attempts to cause, or who in the course of violating
15 subsection (a) of this section causes, bodily injury to a

1 peace officer while engaged in the lawful performance of
2 his official duties is guilty of a felony punishable by
3 imprisonment for not more than ten (10) years.

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2026.
