Driver's and motor vehicle services-third party providers.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; authorizing third party
2 providers to provide driver's license and motor vehicle
3 services as specified; creating the motor vehicle division
4 partner program; making conforming amendments; requiring
5 rulemaking; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-1-205 is created to read:

10

11 **31-1-205. Third party providers; motor vehicle**
12 **division partner program.**

13

14 (a) The department may enter into agreements with
15 third party providers to administer written, driving and

1 skills tests for driver's licenses and administer motor
2 vehicle services.

3

4 (b) The department may establish a motor vehicle
5 division partner program to allow third party providers to
6 conduct specified driver's license and motor vehicle
7 services.

8

9 (c) The department shall promulgate rules to
10 implement the provisions of this section, including but not
11 limited to:

12

13 (i) Establishing criteria for the qualifications
14 and certifications of third party providers;

15

16 (ii) If a motor vehicle division partner program
17 is established, defining the scope of services that may be
18 provided by third party providers under the program;

19

20 (iii) Establishing requirements for training,
21 background checks and bonding of third party providers;

22

1 (iv) Ensuring compliance of third party
2 providers with all applicable federal and state laws, rules
3 and regulations, including but not limited to the federal
4 motor carrier safety administration's regulations for
5 commercial driver's license testing and applicable
6 provisions of the Wyoming administrative code;

7

8 (v) Establishing procedures for monitoring and
9 auditing the activities of third party providers to ensure
10 the integrity and security of driver's license and motor
11 vehicle services;

12

13 (vi) Defining the terms and conditions of
14 agreements between the department and third party
15 providers;

16

17 (vii) Establishing fees and compensation
18 structures for services provided by third party providers;

19

20 (viii) Establishing procedures for the
21 suspension or revocation of third party provider services
22 for noncompliance with department rules or agreement
23 conditions.

2 (d) A third party provider acting under the authority
3 granted by this section shall not be considered a
4 governmental entity.

5

6 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-1-203(b) and 31-7-114(f) (intro)
7 are amended to read:

8

9 **31-1-203. Special enforcement officers; summons and**
10 **notice to appear for violations; deposit for appearance;**
11 **disposition of deposit.**

12

13 (b) Employees designated under subsection (a) of this
14 section may issue summons for violations of W.S. 31-1-205,
15 31-4-101, 31-7-106, 31-7-133, 31-18-101 through 31-18-603,
16 31-18-701, 31-18-801 through 31-18-808 and 39-17-208.

18 **31-7-114. Examinations; visual acuity.**

19

20 (f) The department may authorize a person, including
21 an agency of this or another state, an employer, a third
22 party provider pursuant to W.S. 31-1-205, a private driver
23 training facility or other private institution, or a

1 department, agency or instrumentality of local government
2 including fire departments to administer the skills test
3 specified by subsection (a) of this section, provided:

5 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2026.
