

FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact to the judicial system is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

The Department of Corrections (DOC) indicates this bill may create an indeterminable expenditure increase due to the unknown number of individuals to be sentenced pursuant to the proposed legislation. The DOC estimates the annual cost of incarceration is \$45,625 per inmate, including constitutionally required medical costs. The DOC estimates the annual cost of community supervision is \$3,398 per offender.
