This bill removes the requirement for any vehicle to display a license plate on the front, reducing the plate number required from 2 to 1.

Source of expenditure decrease:

The Wyoming Department of Transportation (WYDOT) would only have to make one plate per vehicle. Since the current issue of license plates is already produced, the next six years of savings would primarily originate from reduced sticker production due to the number of plates produced.

Assumptions:

According to WYDOT, the expenditure reduction above would be reduced by the administrative and enforcement impacts from making this bill effective before the next license plate production cycle on January 1, 2033. If this bill went into effect at the start of a new cycle, the additional expenditure reduction from producing one plate per vehicle is estimated at \$331,000; bringing the total annual savings to \$408,268.
