Source of revenue increase:

There is a one-time \$100/SKU (or brand) fee for the registry. Nebraska has about 2,000 products on their directory, but it does vary among states. Some states have several thousand on their registries.

The proposed legislation does outline fines for violations for non-approved products, but it is indeterminable how much noncompliance there will be in the marketplace.

Assumptions:

The estimate assumes 1,000 products to be listed on the Wyoming registry initially, and then slower growth moving forward.

In addition, it is likely that sales of non-approved vapor products are already occurring in Wyoming or being sold into Wyoming from out-of-state sources. Banning or limiting any of these products would be a potential revenue decrease for both sales tax and tobacco tax, but the impact is indeterminable.
