The 0600 series funding will be used to establish a reenlistment and extension bonus program and pay a reenlistment and extension bonus at a rate not to exceed \$5,000 per occurrence to qualified members of the Wyoming National Guard who reenlist or extend their service. The Military Department estimates a two-year retention population of 214 personnel for the upcoming biennium to support retention efforts and meet strength goals, which would result in a maximum potential expenditure of \$1,070,000.

The Military Department indicates a one-time expenditure increase of \$7,500 to integrate the reenlistment and extension bonus program into the existing recruiting program and make modifications to the website used for recruiting efforts. The one-time expenditure increase could be considered an administrative cost. However, for simplicity and to follow consistent practice on legislation of this type, it is included on the fiscal note.
