Source of expenditure increase:

This bill necessitates programming time to develop additional license draws to accommodate a landowner license cap. The estimate is based on 2 hours of programmer time at an hourly rate of \$62 to modify the draw.

Assumptions:

The estimate assumes that the cap will require additional drawings to administer a cap on full and reduced-price elk, deer, antelope and turkey licenses for landowners.

The expenditure increase reflected above could be considered an administrative cost. However, for simplicity and to follow consistent practice on legislation of this type, it is included on the fiscal note.

In addition, Game and Fish assumes that all licenses across hunt areas and species will be sold resulting in minimal to no impact on license revenue.
