Description of appropriation:

This appropriation will be expended to hire a contractor to perform a groundwater study for the fiscal year (FY) 2027-2028 biennium. The State Engineer's Office expects the appropriation to cover one comprehensive groundwater study in a single, specific control area where some existing data and modeling is available. The State Engineer's Office anticipates expending the full appropriation in FY 2027.
