Maximum payment. 9 10 (a) Except as provided by W.S. 27-3-316 and 11 subsection (b) of this section, the maximum amount of 12 benefits payable to any eliqible individual person in a 13 benefit year shall not exceed twenty-six (26) twenty (20) times his the person's weekly benefit or thirty percent 14 15 (30%) of his the person's wages payable for insured work in 16 his the person's base period, whichever is less. Appointments, 17 vacancies and expiration of terms shall be in accordance with W.S. 28-12-101 through 28-12-103. A member shall not 18 19 hold any state office or serve as an officer or on a 20 committee of any political organization during the term of 21 membership. No more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the

17 ending June 30, 2027. This appropriation shall not be

18 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any

19 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this

20 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,

This act shall apply to all unemployment 2 claims filed on and after January 1, 2027. 3 4 Section 4. 5 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this 6 section, this act is effective January 1, 2027. 7 8 9 (b) Sections 2 and 4 of this act are effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a 10 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of 11 the Wyoming Constitution. 12 13
