- 13 (b) of this section is guilty of felony stalking punishable

14 by imprisonment for not more than ten (10) years, if:

1	(iii) The defendant committed the offense of
2	stalking in violation of any condition of probation, parole
3	or bail;—or

5	(iv) The defendant committed the offense of
6	stalking in violation of a temporary or permanent order of
7	protection issued pursuant to W.S. 7-3-508, 7-3-509,
8	35-21-104 or 35-21-105 or pursuant to a substantially
9	similar law of another jurisdiction; or

11	(v) The defendant committed the offense of
12	stalking against a minor, and the defendant is not less
13	than eighteen (18) years old.

15	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2026.
