Pesticide registration fee increase.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to food and drugs; amending the pesticide  
2 registration fee; specifying distribution of the fee;  
3 specifying applicability; and providing for an effective  
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-356(d) is amended to read:

10 **35-7-356. Registration.**

12 (d) Every registrant of a pesticide or device shall  
13 pay an annual registration fee of ~~one hundred forty dollars~~  
14 ~~(\$140.00)~~ two hundred ten dollars (\$210.00) for each  
15 product registered. All registrations shall expire on

1 December 31 of each year, following the date of the  
2 registration, and may thereupon be renewed for successive  
3 periods of twelve (12) months upon payment of the proper  
4 fee. ~~One hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00)~~ One hundred  
5 ninety-five dollars (\$195.00) of the fee collected pursuant  
6 to this subsection shall be deposited in the special  
7 natural resource account in the department of agriculture  
8 which is hereby created. Funds in the special natural  
9 resource account are continuously appropriated to the  
10 department and shall only be used to provide funding for  
11 the pesticide registration fee program. Fifteen dollars  
12 (\$15.00) of the fee collected pursuant to this subsection  
13 shall be deposited in the pesticide education account in  
14 the department of agriculture which is hereby created.  
15 Funds in the pesticide education account are continuously  
16 appropriated to the department and shall only be used to  
17 provide funding for the pesticide applicator certification  
18 program provided by the University of Wyoming.

20 **Section 2.** This act shall apply to each product  
21 initially registered or renewed on or after July 1, 2026.

1       **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2026.
