Concealed carry-colleges and universities.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to weapons; specifying that persons who are  
2 authorized to carry concealed weapons without a permit may  
3 do so at any public college or university facility; making  
4 conforming amendments; repealing obsolete provisions; and  
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9       **Section 1.** W.S. 6-8-105(b) by creating a new  
10 paragraph (iv), by renumbering (iv) as (v) and (f) (intro)  
11 is amended to read:

13       **6-8-105. Exceptions for state issued concealed carry**  
14 **permits; penalty.**

2           (b) Persons lawfully carrying concealed weapons in  
3 Wyoming under W.S. 6-8-104(a)(ii) through (iv) may carry a  
4 concealed weapon in the following places:

6           (iv) Any public college or university facility,  
7 except for any public college or university athletic event  
8 where alcoholic beverages are being sold;

9

10           (iv)(v) Any public building not otherwise  
11 prohibited under W.S. 6-8-104(t) or regulated under this  
12 section.

14           (f) The board of trustees in each school district may  
15 adopt rules and regulations to govern employees and  
16 volunteers lawfully carrying concealed weapons in Wyoming  
17 under W.S. 6-8-104 on or in any property or facility owned  
18 or leased by the school district. If no rules and  
19 regulations are adopted under this subsection, an employee  
20 or a volunteer with a permit to conceal carry under W.S.  
21 6-8-104(a)(ii) may carry a concealed weapon under W.S.  
22 6-8-105(c)(ii) or (iii) paragraph (b)(iv) or (c)(ii) of  
23 this section onto school property. Any rules and

1 regulations adopted under this subsection shall only apply  
2 to persons who are volunteers or employees, as defined by  
3 subsection (g) of this section. The rules under this  
4 subsection shall:

6 **Section 2.** W.S. 6-8-105(c)(iii) is repealed.

7

8 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2026.
