A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of the government;
2 specifying requirements for the director of the department
3 of audit to post specified reports on the department's
4 website; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-1-507 by creating a new subsection
9 (o) is amended to read:

10

11 **9-1-507. Examination of books of state institutions,**
12 **agencies and certain districts and entities; independent**
13 **audit authorized; guidelines.**

1 (o) The director of the state department of audit
2 shall post the following reports and information on the
3 department's official website not later than the dates
4 specified in this subsection:

6 (i) Reports filed by counties, cities, towns,
7 special districts and other entities submitted under
8 paragraph (a)(vii) of this section, which shall be posted
9 on the department's website not later than December 31 of
10 each year;

11
12 (ii) Budgets submitted by special districts and
13 other entities under paragraph (a)(viii) of this section,
14 which shall be posted on the department's website not later
15 than thirty (30) days after the budgets are due to the
16 department under paragraph (a)(viii) of this section;

18 (iii) Budgets filed by special districts under
19 W.S. 16-12-408(a), which shall be posted on the
20 department's website not later than thirty (30) days after
21 the budgets are due to the department under W.S.
22 16-12-408(a);

1 (iv) Annual audits submitted under W.S.
2 9-1-507(a)(iii)(A) and (a)(ix)(A) and 16-4-121(e) and (f),
3 which shall be posted on the department's website not later
4 than thirty (30) days after the annual audits are due to
5 the department under W.S. 16-4-121.

7 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
8 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
9 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
10 Constitution.
