A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state funded capital construction; providing
2 definitions; providing appropriations for purposes related to
3 state funded capital construction and major maintenance; making
4 appropriations subject to terms and conditions as specified; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

11 (a) As used in this act:

12

13 (i) "Appropriation" means the authorizations granted by
14 the legislature under this act to make expenditures from and to
15 incur obligations against the general and other funds as
16 specified;

1 provided. The amounts appropriated in this act are intended to
2 provide a maximum amount for each project from any source,
3 excluding contingency funding, and shall not be construed to be an
4 entitlement or guaranteed amount. This subsection shall not apply
5 to appropriations for major maintenance in this act, except as
6 specifically provided.

11 owner's representative for the veterans' home of Wyoming remodel. From this
12 general fund appropriation, the department may expend an amount not to exceed
13 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) for retention of the qualified
14 owner's representative.

16 3. (a) Federal funds received by the state of Wyoming for state run veterans'
17 home facilities shall:

15 (i) Thirty-seven and sixty-six hundredths
16 percent (37.66%) to the state construction department for
17 state buildings, facilities and sites managed by the state
18 building commission and state institutions;

20 (ii) Eight and one hundredth percent (8.01%) to
21 the department of state parks and cultural resources to
22 fund major maintenance requests submitted by the department
23 of state parks and cultural resources as approved by the

1 state building commission;

2

3 (iii) Thirty-six and four-tenths percent (36.4%)
4 to the University of Wyoming for university buildings,
5 facilities and sites, excluding student housing, the
6 student union and auxiliary services areas, the latter
7 being those areas funded by university self-sustaining
8 revenues;

9

10 (iv) Seventeen and ninety-three hundredths
11 percent (17.93%) to the state construction department for
12 community college district buildings, facilities and sites.
