License plate decal-Wyoming veterans.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing for a decal
2 designating Wyoming veterans to attach to a license plate;
3 providing for a decal fee; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-217(e) by creating a new
9 paragraph (vi) and by creating new subsections (n) and (o)
10 is amended to read:

11

12 **31-2-217. Special plates; Pearl Harbor survivors;**
13 **national guard members; armed forces veterans; purple heart**
14 **recipients; women armed forces veteran decals; Wyoming**
15 **armed forces veteran decals.**

2 (e) Any person who is a Wyoming resident at the time
3 of application may apply under this section for:

4

5 (vi) A Wyoming veteran decal by presenting
6 documentation that the person is an honorably discharged
7 veteran of the United States armed forces who resides in
8 Wyoming.

9

10 (n) The decal designating a Wyoming veteran shall
11 bear a distinctive symbol or letters identifying the
12 registrant as an honorably discharged veteran of the United
13 States armed forces who resides in Wyoming. The decal shall
14 be attached in the lower left corner of the license plate
15 without obscuring any other symbols, letters or numbers on
16 the license plate. Application forms shall be available at
17 all county treasurer's offices. Each applicant for a decal
18 under this subsection shall submit an administration fee
19 with the application. The fee shall be in an amount
20 determined by the department to be sufficient to recover
21 reasonable administrative costs of the decal, but not more
22 than five dollars (\$5.00) per set of decals for any one (1)
23 vehicle. Upon completion of the application, receipt of the

1 administration fee and issuance or renewal of a license
2 plate under this article, the county treasurer shall issue
3 to the applicant the number of decals corresponding to the
4 number of license plates issued or renewed. Decals issued
5 under this subsection shall not be required to be renewed
6 upon renewal of a license plate. The replacement fee for a
7 decals under this subsection shall be the same as for the
8 original decal. Any applicant for Wyoming veteran decals
9 under this subsection shall be:

10
11 (i) A Wyoming resident at the time of
12 application; and

13
14 (ii) An honorably discharged veteran who served
15 in the armed forces of the United States whose written
16 evidence of separation from the armed forces shows an
17 honorable discharge or the rendition of honorable military
18 service.

19
20 (o) A person may obtain a decal under either W.S.
21 31-2-217(n) or 31-2-217(m), but not both.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2026.
