1 AN ACT relating to probation and parole generally;
2 clarifying that judicial convictions and administrative
3 disciplinary findings for assault or escape determine
4 parole ineligibility; and providing for an effective date.

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-13-402(b)(intro) is amended to

12 **eligibility for parole; immunity.**

1 (b) A prisoner is not eligible for parole on a
2 sentence if, while serving that sentence, he has been
3 convicted in the district court or found, by a final
4 determination of the Wyoming department of corrections
5 administrative hearing process, of having:
