1 AN ACT relating to gaming; amending the distribution of
2 online sports wagering revenue for problem gaming treatment
3 and programs; specifying requirements; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-24-104(a) is amended to read:

10 **9-24-104. Distribution of revenue.**

11

12 (a) Not later than the fifteenth day of each month,
13 in accordance with commission rules, a sports wagering
14 operator shall remit ten percent (10%) of online sports
15 wagering revenue from the prior month to the commission,

1 except as provided in subsection (b) of this section. Each
2 fiscal year, the first three hundred thousand dollars
3 (\$300,000.00) of revenue generated under this section is
4 continuously appropriated to the ~~department of health to be~~
5 ~~distributed to the counties~~ commission for the purpose of
6 funding ~~county health~~ programs to prevent and treat
7 problematic gambling behavior and the remainder of monies
8 remitted to the commission shall be deposited by the state
9 treasurer into the general fund. For purposes of this
10 subsection, the commission may contract with persons for
11 the provision of programs to prevent and treat problematic
12 gambling behavior.

14 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2026.
