State heritage lands-protection and revenue.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state lands; authorizing the board of
 2 land commissioners to designate state land as a state
 3 heritage site; providing a process for the nomination and
 4 review of state land for designation as a state heritage
 5 site; providing definitions; nominating the Glenrock
 6 buffalo jump for designation as a state heritage site; and
 7 providing for an effective date.

8

9 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

10

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-1-122 is created to read:

12

13 **36-1-122. Designation of land as a state heritage**
 14 **site.**

15

1 (a) When the designation is consistent with the
2 greatest long-term benefit of the state land trust
3 beneficiaries, the board may designate specific parcels of
4 state land as a state heritage site if the board finds that
5 the land possesses exceptional archeological, historical or
6 cultural value that would be irreparably degraded by
7 industrial use on the land.

8

9 (b) The board may consider state lands for
10 designation as a state heritage site under this section on
11 its own motion. In addition, any citizen of Wyoming, the
12 legislature, any local government entity, a tribal
13 government of either the Northern Arapaho or Eastern
14 Shoshone tribes or the state archeologist may nominate
15 lands for designation as a state heritage site under this
16 section by making an application to the department of state
17 parks and cultural resources. The department of state parks
18 and cultural resources shall review any state lands
19 nominated for designation as a state heritage site under
20 this subsection and shall provide a recommendation to the
21 board after consultation with the Wyoming parks and
22 cultural resources commission and the state historic
23 preservation office.

1

2 (c) Any lands designated by the board as a state
3 heritage site, after consideration of any recommendation
4 under subsection (b) of this section, shall be subject to
5 the following:

6

7 (i) The board shall not authorize any industrial
8 use on the state heritage site or on any surrounding lands
9 that significantly impairs the visual integrity or
10 archaeological, historical or cultural value of the site;

11

12 (ii) The board shall consider the issuance of
13 leases of the state heritage site for the greatest benefit
14 to trust beneficiaries, including leases for:

15

16 (A) Educational and research programs;

17

18 (B) Sustainable tourism related activities,
19 including guided tours of the state heritage site;

20

21 (C) Recreational use that the board finds
22 will not deplete, destroy or permanently alter the state
23 heritage site.

1

2 **Section 2.** W.S. 36-1-101(a) by creating a new
3 paragraph (ix) and 36-4-104 by creating a new subsection
4 (g) are amended to read:

5

6 **36-1-101. Definitions.**

7

8 (a) Unless the context indicates otherwise, as used
9 in this act:

10

11 (ix) "Greatest benefit" or "greatest long-term
12 benefit" shall include a consideration of the long-term
13 protection of the financial and intrinsic value of the
14 land. For any land designated as a state heritage site,
15 "greatest benefit" shall include a consideration of the
16 need to mitigate any depletion or alteration of the state
17 heritage site.

18

19 **36-4-104. Powers; interpretive service agreements.**

20

21 (g) The department, in consultation with the
22 commission and the state historic preservation office,
23 shall accept applications for designation of state lands as

1 a state heritage site and shall make recommendations to the
2 board of land commissioners as provided by W.S.
3 36-1-122(b).

4

5 **Section 3.** The legislature hereby nominates the
6 Glenrock buffalo jump as described in the national register
7 of historic places for designation as a state heritage site
8 under W.S. 36-1-122 as created by section 1 of this act.

9

10 **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2026.
