## A JOINT RESOLUTION

for

- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress prohibit unauthorized
- 2 atmospheric geoengineering and weather modification in the
- 3 state of Wyoming.

4

- 5 WHEREAS, it is documented that federal agencies, military
- 6 contractors or private entities acting on behalf of or at the
- 7 request of the federal government may be engaging in
- 8 geoengineering experiments, including but not limited to
- 9 solar radiation management, stratospheric aerosol injection
- 10 and weather modification by dispersing chemicals or
- 11 particulates into the atmosphere without public knowledge or
- 12 consent; and

13

- 14 WHEREAS, such activities are currently allowed without
- 15 oversight in Wyoming's airspace and may involve substances

- 1 such as aluminum oxide, barium, stratospheric sulfates or
- 2 other compounds, with unknown or unreported impacts on human
- 3 health, livestock, crops, ecosystems and weather stability;
- 4 and

- 6 WHEREAS, the Wyoming department of environmental quality
- 7 (DEQ) is charged with protecting the safety and quality of
- 8 the state's air, water and soil, and must be empowered to
- 9 investigate and stop unauthorized atmospheric contamination
- 10 within Wyoming's jurisdiction; and

- 12 WHEREAS, it is the constitutional duty of state government to
- 13 safeguard public health, defend private property, protect
- 14 agricultural integrity and assert state sovereignty over
- 15 activities conducted within its borders and above its skies
- 16 under the tenth amendment of the United States constitution;
- 17 and

- 19 WHEREAS, multiple states, including Tennessee and Florida,
- 20 have now enacted legislation prohibiting geoengineering
- 21 modifications, and dozens more are considering similar laws
- 22 to preserve natural climate systems and ensure transparency
- 23 in all atmospheric activity.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE

3 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

4

5 **Section 1.** That the Wyoming Legislature supports the

6 drafting and passage of legislation to:

7

8 (a) Prohibit the intentional injection, dispersion or

9 release of chemical, biological or radiological substances

10 into the atmosphere for the purpose of weather modification,

11 solar radiation management or environmental engineering

12 without the express approval of the state of Wyoming;

13

14 (b) Ban the use of unmarked aircraft, drones, balloons

15 or space-based platforms to conduct geoengineering

16 modifications over the state of Wyoming;

17

18 (c) Make such unauthorized acts a felony offense,

19 encouraging partnerships between the relevant federal law

20 enforcement agencies and the Wyoming DEQ or relevant state

21 law enforcement entities to enforce such felonies, with

22 substantial fines and criminal penalties per violation; and

1 (d) Formally reject any federal, internationa	T 03

2 foreign-sponsored geoengineering programs conducted over

3 Wyoming airspace without full disclosure, state consent and

4 public transparency.

6 Section 2.

7

8 (a) That the Wyoming Legislature urges all elected

9 officials, agencies and candidates to support legislation

10 that preserves Wyoming's natural skies, defends individual

11 and agricultural health and asserts constitutional control

12 over state airspace; and

13

14 (b) That the Wyoming Legislature does not support the

15 banning of ground-based and aerosol cloud seeding in Wyoming.

16

17 **Section 3.** That the Secretary of State of Wyoming

18 transmit copies of this resolution to the President of the

19 United States, to the President of the Senate and the Speaker

20 of the House of Representatives of the United States Congress

21 and to the Wyoming Congressional Delegation.
