10 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend the Wyoming

11 Constitution by creating Article 19, Section 12 is proposed

12 for submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the

13 next general election for approval or rejection to become

- 1 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a majority
- 2 of the electors at the election:

- 4 Article 19, Section 12. Storage of high-level
- 5 radioactive waste and spent nuclear fuel; vote required.

- 7 (a) No storage, siting or placement of high-level
- 8 radioactive waste shall be authorized under state law and
- 9 occur except upon an affirmative vote of the people of the
- 10 state.

- 12 (b) No storage, siting or placement of spent nuclear
- 13 fuel shall be authorized under state law and occur except
- 14 upon an affirmative vote of the people of the state.

2 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse

3 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

5 The adoption of this amendment would require an affirmative

6 vote of the people of the state before any high-level

7 radioactive waste or spent nuclear fuel can be stored in

8 Wyoming.
