A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; creating the  
2 criminal offense of absconding for criminal purposes;  
3 specifying penalties; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-5-215 is created to read:

8

9 **6-5-215. Absconding for criminal purposes; penalty.**

10

11 (a) A person is guilty of absconding for criminal  
12 purposes if the person:

13

14 (i) Travels from one (1) county to another  
15 county in Wyoming or from one (1) county in Wyoming to  
16 another jurisdiction outside of Wyoming:

1

2 (A) After having committed any criminal  
3 offense under this title or the Wyoming Controlled  
4 Substances Act of 1971;

5

6 (B) With the intent to commit an additional  
7 criminal offense under this title or the Wyoming Controlled  
8 Substances Act of 1971 after having committed an offense in  
9 the original county;

10

11 (C) To dispose of or conceal the proceeds,  
12 property or other items of value obtained after committing  
13 any criminal offense under this title or the Wyoming  
14 Controlled Substances Act of 1971; or

15

16 (D) In furtherance of any felony offense.

17

18 (b) The penalty for absconding for criminal purposes  
19 shall be the same as the penalty for the most serious crime  
20 that was committed, was intended to be committed or  
21 furthered as a result of the absconding for criminal  
22 purposes.

1       **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2026.
