(ix) "Qualified elector" means a natural person 1 2 who: 3 4 (C) Will be at least eighteen (18) years of age on the day of the next election; at which he may offer 5 6 to vote; 7 8 (G) Has been a bona fide resident of Wyoming for not less than thirty (30) days before the date 9 10 of the next election. at which he offers to vote. 11 12 22-1-102. Definitions. 13 14 The definitions contained in this chapter apply (a) to words and phrases used in this Election Code and govern 15 16 the construction of those words and phrases unless they are 17 specifically modified by the context in which they appear. As used in this Election Code: 18 19 20 (xxvi) "Qualified elector" includes every citizen of the United States who is a bona fide resident of 21 Wyoming, has been a bona fide resident of Wyoming for not 22 23 less than thirty (30) days before the date of the next
