10 **Section 1.** W.S. 16-9-113 is created to read:

5 this subsection shall be reported to the joint

(b) From funds appropriated for that purpose, the 9 department of transportation is authorized to provide 10 11 grants to a governing body for any shortfall in funding 12 necessary to operate the current 911 system. Any governing body that currently operates a 911 system may apply to the 13 department of transportation for a grant as provided in 14 governing body shall 15 this section.
