A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
2 Constitution to require that fines and penalties collected
3 under the general laws of the state be applied to the
4 construction or maintenance of Wyoming's roadways.

6 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,*
7 *two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting*
8 *separately, concurring therein:*

10 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
11 Constitution, Article 7, Section 5 is proposed for
12 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
13 next general election for approval or rejection to become

1 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
2 majority of the electors at the election:

4 **Article 7, Section 5. Fines and penalties ~~to belong~~**
5 **~~to public school fund~~dedicated to highways.**

6
7 All fines and penalties under general laws of the state
8 shall ~~belong to the public school fund of the respective~~
9 ~~counties and be paid over to the custodians of such funds~~
10 ~~for the current support of the public schools therein~~be
11 dedicated to the construction, improvement or maintenance
12 of Wyoming's highways and be paid to the custodians of such
13 funds which are dedicated to the construction, improvement
14 or maintenance of Wyoming's highways.

15
16 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
17 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

18
19 The adoption of the proposed amendment will reassign fine
20 and penalty revenues from the public school fund to funds
21 used for the construction, improvement or maintenance of
22 Wyoming's roadways.
