- 10 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
- 11 Constitution, Article 7, Section 5 is proposed for
- 12 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
- 13 next general election for approval or rejection to become

- 1 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
- 2 majority of the electors at the election:

- 4 Article 7, Section 5. Fines and penalties to belong
- 5 to public school funddedicated to highways.

- 7 All fines and penalties under general laws of the state
- 8 shall belong to the public school fund of the respective
- 9 counties and be paid over to the custodians of such funds
- 10 for the current support of the public schools thereinbe
- 11 dedicated to the construction, improvement or maintenance
- 12 of Wyoming's highways and be paid to the custodians of such
- 13 funds which are dedicated to the construction, improvement
- 14 or maintenance of Wyoming's highways.

- 16 Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse
- 17 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

- 19 The adoption of the proposed amendment will reassign fine
- 20 and penalty revenues from the public school fund to funds
- 21 used for the construction, improvement or maintenance of
- 22 Wyoming's roadways.
