## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to highway funding; assigning penalty and 2 fine revenues to the highway fund as specified; and 3 providing for an effective date. 4 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 6 7 \*\*\*STAFF COMMENT\*\*\* This bill is a companion bill to 12LSO42. 12LSO42 8 9 proposes a constitutional amendment which would 10 require fines/penalties to be dedicated to the 11 highway fund. 12 Section 1. W.S. 24-1-119 is amended to read: 13 14 15 24-1-119. State highway fund created; income and 16 expenditure.

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There is created a fund known as the state highway 2 fund, to the credit of which the state treasurer, who is 3 designated as the state official to receive all amounts 4 paid by the United States under the act of congress 5 approved July 11, 1916, shall place all monies previously 6 7 received for the fund, all money subsequently received from United States, under cooperative agreements 8 the as authorized, all money derived from taxes levied for such 9 purpose or appropriated for the fund, all monies received 10 11 from the sale of state bonds for highway construction or 12 improvement, all money received from the counties under 13 cooperative agreements as hereinbefore authorized, and all 14 other monies received from donations or bequests, which may be accepted by the commission on behalf of the state of 15 Wyoming, or from any source designated by law for that 16 17 purpose. All monies in the fund shall be available for the 18 purpose of this act without further appropriation and no warrant shall be drawn on the fund excepting on a voucher 19 approved by the director of 20 the department of transportation or an assistant authorized by the director 21 22 and approved by the transportation commission. In addition 23 to any other accounts established within the highway fund,

| 3  | into a special account within the highway fund, in the  |
| 4  | state of Wyoming's Online Financial System, and shall be  |
| 5  | applied only for the construction, improvement or   |
| 6  | maintenance of Wyoming's highways. It is provided that  |
| 7  | seventy-five percent (75%) of the amount of any bond issue  |
| 8  | subsequently issued by the state of Wyoming for the   |
| 9  | construction or improvement of state highways, after the  |
| 10   | payment of overhead expense, shall be apportioned to and  |
| 11   | spent in each county in the proportion which the assessed   |
| 12   | valuation of each county by the last general assessment   |
| 13   | bears to the total assessment of the state.   |

These<br>references will need to be amended to require<br>deposit into the highway fund. |
