13 (a) As used in this act:

2	(xvi) "Permissible investments" means:
3	
4	(H) Receivables which are due to a licensee
5	from its authorized delegates or subdelegates which are not
6	past due or doubtful of collection; - or
7	
8	(J) Any other investments or security
9	device approved by the commissioner; - or
10	
11	(K) Digital currency owned by the licensee,
12	but only to the extent of outstanding transmission
13	obligations received by the licensee in like kind digital
14	currency.
15	
16	(xxii) "Digital currency" means any type of
17	digital representation of value used as a medium of
18	exchange, a unit of account or a store of value that is not
19	considered a centralized currency recognized by the United
20	States government as legal tender. "Digital currency" does
21	<pre>not include:</pre>
22	

1	(A) Stored value redeemable exclusively in
2	goods or services limited to transactions involving a
3	defined merchant;
4	
5	(B) Units of value that are issued in
6	customer affinity or rewards programs and that cannot be
7	redeemed for either fiat or digital currencies.
8	
9	(xxiii) "Outstanding transmission obligation"
10	means:
11	
12	(A) Any payment instrument or stored value
13	issued by the licensee which has been sold in the United
14	States directly by the licensee or any payment instrument
15	or stored value issued by the licensee which has been sold
16	by an authorized delegate or subdelegate of the licensee in
17	the United States, which has been reported to the licensee
18	as having been sold and which has not yet been paid or
19	refunded by or for the licensee;
20	
21	(B) Any money or monetary value received by
22	the licensee for transmission that has not been remitted to

23 the payee or refunded to the sender.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2017.
