

## APPENDIX 10

### 2016 Voting Violations in Wyoming Elections—Surveyed April-May 2017

County Clerks were asked the following questions with regard to voters who voted in the 2016 Elections who were NOT eligible to vote and the current disposition of these cases.

1. Did you have felons who voted who should have not been able to vote and if so how many were flagged or brought to your attention.
2. Did you have Non-citizens who voted who should have not been able to vote and if so how many were flagged or brought to your attention.
3. In any of the cases in #1 and #2, did you do any further work to assure they truly were felons or non-citizens before turning them over to the county attorney (or district attorney). If so, what methods did you use and did any of your numbers change due to these research methods.
4. After all research and letters sent to voters about their situations, how many actual cases (felon and non-citizens) did you turn over to the county attorney (or district attorney).
5. Did your county attorney (or district attorney) indicate they will file charges against these individuals.
6. Did your attorney indicate that since the new automatic restoration of rights (which will go into effect as amended July 1, 2017) will deter them from prosecution this time around.
