**Comments**

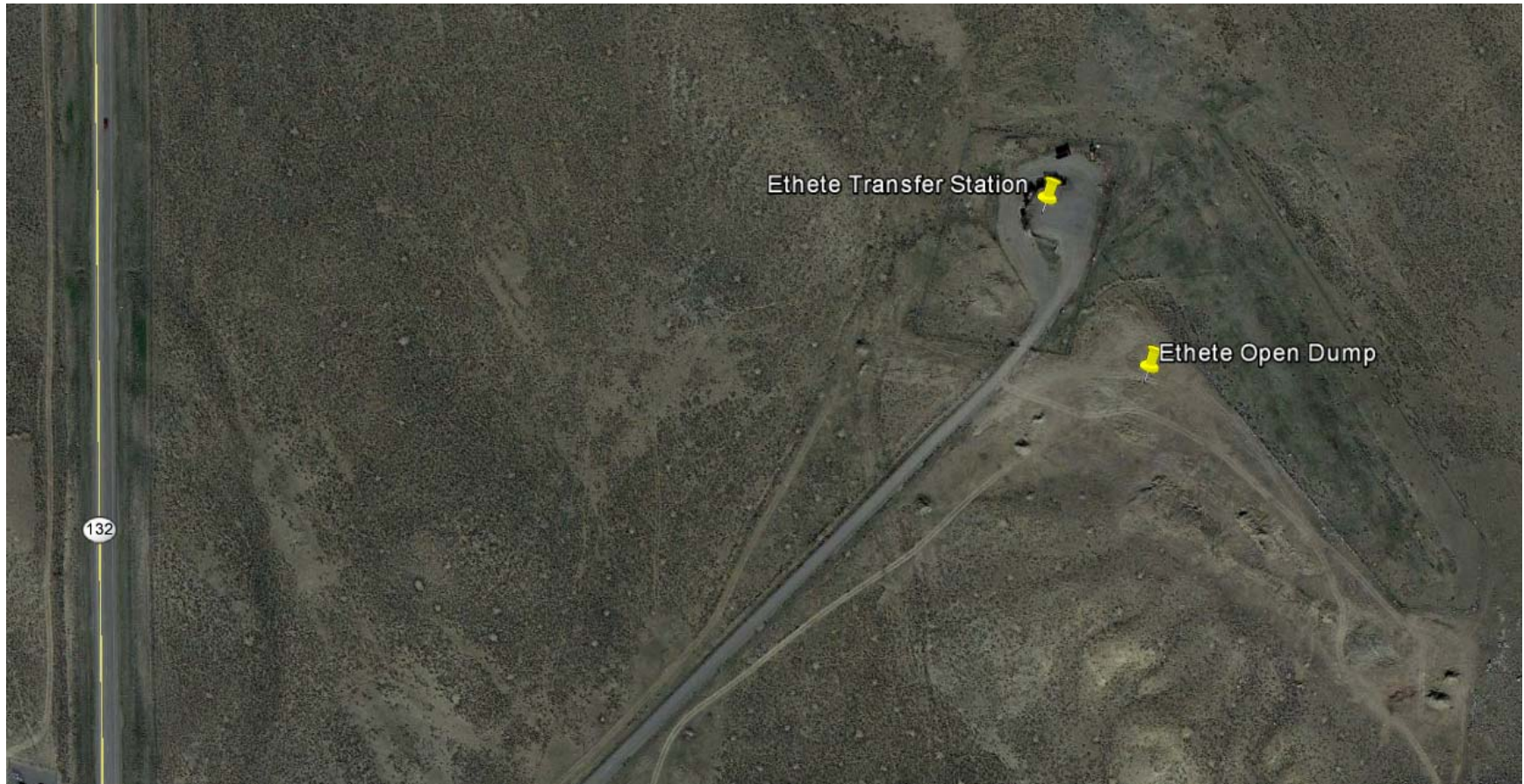
There is a large amount of open dumping near the site of the transfer station. Construction debris, Tires, white goods, electronics, furniture, and mattresses have been collected and spread throughout the acreage adjacent to the transfer station. It has been reported that illegal dumpers will dump solid waste in plain site of the Transfer Station employees. There is no regulation or enforcement of the dumping which occurs. I visited the site with Ryan Ortiz on January 28, 2016 and returned to visit the site with Danny Ortiz on February 1, 2016. See attached photos.
