MISDEMEANOR CRIMES WITH A POSSIBILITY OF JAIL TIME

The following list contains misdemeanor crimes in Wyoming that come with the possibility of jail time. Unless otherwise noted, the misdemeanors are punishable by not more than six (6) months of imprisonment and/or a fine not to exceed \$750.00. In total, there are 348 misdemeanors that come with the possibility of jail time.
