1 (d) The rules established under subsection (a) of 2 this section shall: 3 4 (i) Provide that good time may be awarded for 5 time the sentencing court awards as jail credit in the 6 judgment and sentence if the inmate or parolee would have otherwise received good time credit if the inmate or 7 parolee had served that time in an institution eligible 8 9 under subsection (a) of this section; 10 11 (ii) Provide that good time may be awarded for 12 any time an inmate or parolee spends in custody from the date of sentencing until admission to an institution 13 14 eligible under subsection (a) of this section; 15 16 (iii) Require the department to consult with the 17 county sheriff to determine whether good time should be 18 awarded to an inmate or parolee before awarding good time for jail credit under this subsection. 19 20 Section 2. 21 22

1 (a) The provisions of this act shall apply to all 2 persons who, on or after the effective date of this act, 3 are: 4 5 (i) Currently incarcerated pending trial; 6 7 (ii) Convicted of a crime and currently awaiting sentencing; 8 9 10 (iii) Sentenced for any crime and currently 11 incarcerated; 12 13 (iv) Currently serving a sentence; 14 15 (v) Currently on parole. 16 17 Section 3. The governor, in consultation with the 18 board of parole and the department of corrections, shall 19 promulgate any rules necessary to implement this act by 20 July 1, 2020. 21 22 Section 4.

2	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
3	section, this act is effective July 1, 2020.

5	(b) Sections 3 and 4 of this act are effective
6	immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a
7	bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of
8	the Wyoming Constitution.
