Subject: WDE Data Collection and Reporting Requirements

Background

During the 2018-19 school year the Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) data and school foundation teams met with program managers and reviewed all data collections and data collection processes to identify ways to decrease data burden on the school districts.

Data Collections and Elements Eliminated

As a result two collections and multiple elements were eliminated and are listed below:

- WDE613 Gifted and Talented Survey. W.S. 21-9-101 statute requires school districts to have a gifted and talented program. This collection was created at the time of the statute so the WDE accreditation team could follow up and ensure districts were in compliance. Gifted and talented programs are well established and the collection is no longer necessary.
- WDE453 Instructional Foundations for Kindergarten collection was eliminated as a result of 2019 SF0129 that amended W.S. 21-4-302.
- WDE103 Reimbursable Pupil Transportation Expenditures
 Report was reduced from 74 elements to 15 with plans to
 combine the remainder of the collection with the WDE601 WISE
 Annual District Report in the next year, completely eliminating
 the WDE103.
- WDE401 Reimbursable Special Education Expenditures Report was reduced from 47 elements to 25. We additionally preloaded staff records provided in the WDE602 to prevent them from reporting staff information twice.

 $^{1 \\ \}text{The WDE is reopening a collection due to a statutory change made during the 2019 session. As a result of the 2019 HB0297, the WDE will collect K-2 ELA proficiency rates by school and grade through the WDE626 Early Literacy - Longitudinal Data collection.}$

 WDE608 School District Directory Data Collection will be reduced by four elements when the collection reopens in May 2020.

Following this review, WDE staff determined that the remaining data collections and elements are either federally required or are directly related to state funding, accountability, or accreditation, and therefore necessary for monitoring school and student performance. The full list of required data collections for school districts is included in Appendix A.

Data Collection Automation

The WDE is working to reduce data burden through the automation of data collections. Over the past two years, the WDE has developed a new data collection system named the Wyoming Interoperable Data System (WINDS), which has connected all 48 school districts via SIF (a standardized data interchange protocol). Through WINDS, the following enhancements to state education data collection have or are anticipated to occur:

- Ability to more seamlessly collect student, enrollment, and assessment data.
- Automation of student identifiers (WISER) to district student information systems (SIS).
- Dashboard capabilities enabling districts to view and fix errors directly.
- Piloting automation of additional data reports such as attendance, membership and course inventory.
