
DELEGATE REGISTRATION



PORTAL LOGIN/ CREATE ACCOUNT

The web address for WORx is https://worxpdmp.com/

To create an account, please choose between a prescriber, pharmacist or a delegate account. A pharmacist or practitioner can appoint a person that may request a patient profile from the WORx Database. If you already have an account with the Wyoming Online Prescription Database, please enter your username and password that you originally registered with

DELEGATES

Practitioner's Delegate

- If delegate chooses a practitioner supervisor
- Delegates must enter the practitioner's DEA number
- Practitioner's state regulatory board license number
- Practitioner's controlled substance registration number
- Practitioner's WORx Email address
- If successful the delegate will get a screen like the example below

You must select a valid supervisor to search or run reports. Pending authorization requests must be approved by your Supervisor.

An email is sent to the supervisor

Rejected Delegates




The process for approving delegates doesn't take much time. While you can only have two "active" delegates at one time you can have as many sign-up as you need. This becomes delegate management.

- Login into WORx
- There are four tabs across the top, "Home", "Prescriptions", "Reports" and "Delegates"
- Choose "Delegates"
- Should come to a page similar to this example shown below:




INTERCONNECT PMP

LIMITATIONS

- Delegates may be limited by other State's laws
 - Licensed verses unlicensed (i.e. Colorado RPTs are unlicensed)
- Only two delegates may be active at a time
 - Five delegates per user equals ~20,000 people with access
 - Unlimited number of registered delegates
 - Must be employed by the location (no pharmacy students on rotations)
- Delegates may register under multiple providers (no limit)

PENDING UPDATES

- Active Alerts
 - Will allow for users to set thresholds
 - i.e. medication, pharmacies, or prescribers
 - Next day notifications
- Calculators
 - MME
 - Days supply

SECURITY UPDATES



1) Passwords

- Increase to eight characters
 - Strengthens to allow for other changes
- Required reset every 6 months
 - Longest timeframe allowed

2) Remember Me Option

- Users can select to have their computer remembered
- Recertified every 30 days
- Only certifies one computer at a time
 - System limit if switching between several

3) Security Questions

- If computer is remembered, questions only utilized if password is forgotten
- Rotates through three possibilities

Impact

- Simplify login process
 - mandatory searching going into effect
- Goal of increased use
- In response to feedback from practitioners
 - Rock Springs
 - Jackson
