2	threat or by deception, or he receives, loans money by pawn
3	or pledge on or disposes of the property of another person
4	that he knew or reasonably should have known was stolen,

7	(ii) Knowingly uses, receives, conceals,
8	abandons or disposes of the property in such manner as to
9	deprive the other person of its use or benefit; or

12	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
