5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 16-4-405(a) by creating a new
8 paragraph (xii) and (c) is amended to read:

10 **16-4-405. Executive sessions.**

12 (a) A governing body of an agency may hold executive
13 sessions not open to the public:

(xii) To consider, discuss and conduct safety and security planning that, if disclosed, would pose a threat to the safety of life or property.

(c) Unless a different procedure or vote is otherwise specified by law, an executive session may be held only pursuant to a motion that is duly seconded and carried by majority vote of the members of the governing body in attendance when the motion is made. A motion to hold an executive session which specifies any of the reasons set forth in paragraphs (a)(i) through ~~(xi)~~ (xii) of this section shall be sufficient notice of the issue to be considered in an executive session.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
