2	(xii) To consider, discuss and conduct safety and
3	security planning that, if disclosed, would pose a threat
4	to the safety of life or property.

6	(c) Unless a different procedure or vote is otherwise
7	specified by law, an executive session may be held only
8	pursuant to a motion that is duly seconded and carried by
9	majority vote of the members of the governing body in
10	attendance when the motion is made. A motion to hold an
11	executive session which specifies any of the reasons set
12	forth in paragraphs (a)(i) through (xi) (xii) of this
13	section shall be sufficient notice of the issue to be
14	considered in an executive session.

16	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
17	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
18	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
19	Constitution.
