5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 **Section 1**. W.S. 37-2-107(a) is amended to read:

9 37-2-107. Uniform assessment regarding
10 telecommunications, gas, electric, water and pipeline
11 service; assessment generally.

1	(a) On or before the first day of July of each year
2	the director of revenue shall, by requiring special reports
3	or otherwise, determine the total aggregate amount of the
4	gross Wyoming intrastate retail revenues of all public
5	utilities, entities utilizing public utility facilities in
6	the state to furnish retail utility commodities or services
7	to the public, and providers of telecommunication services,
8	except motor carriers, and those utilities exempted under
9	W.S. 37-2-108, for the preceding calendar year. $\frac{He}{The}$
LO	director shall then determine the ratio that one-half (1/2)
L1	of the total authorized budgeted amount for the biennium is
L2	to the total aggregate gross retail Wyoming intrastate
L3	operating revenues. The resulting percentage factor shall
L4	then be applied to the annual intrastate gross retail
L5	operating revenues of each of such persons for the
L6	preceding calendar year and the result shall be the
L7	assessment of each such person for the ensuing budget
L8	fiscal year. However, the assessment rate against the
L9	persons for any one (1) year shall not exceed .0030 four-
20	thousandths (.004) of the gross Wyoming intrastate retail
21	revenues of the persons. By the first day of August the
22	director of the revenue department shall assess the
23	persons, and one-half $(1/2)$ the assessed fees shall be paid

1	to <u>him the director</u> by the persons on or before the first
2	day of October and one-half $(1/2)$ of the fees shall be paid
3	to him the director by the persons on or before the first
4	day of April in the ensuing year. The director, of the
5	revenue department, in computing the percentage upon which
6	fees for the first fiscal year of the ensuing biennium
7	shall be based, shall deduct any unexpended balance in the
8	commission's account, less an amount equal to the total of
9	all properly authorized outstanding accounts payable, from
10	one-half $(1/2)$ the total authorized budgeted amount for the
11	biennium, and the resultant figure shall be used instead of
12	the one-half $(1/2)$ of the total authorized budgeted amount
13	for the biennium, as above provided. Any unexpended balance
14	in the commission's account shall not lapse at the end of
15	the fiscal period. "Intrastate gross retail operating
16	revenues" as used in this section shall mean intrastate
17	gross revenues derived from the provision of
18	telecommunications, gas, electric, water and pipeline
19	service offered for final consumption and not for resale.
