3	(xlviii) "Diaper" means an absorbent garment
4	worn by humans who are incapable of or have difficulty
5	controlling their bladder or bowel movements including
6	children's diapers and adult diapers;

8	(xlix) "Feminine hygiene products" means
9	tampons, panty liners, menstrual cups, sanitary napkins and
10	other similar tangible personal property designed for use
11	in connection with the human menstrual cycle but shall not
12	include grooming and hygiene products including soaps or
13	cleaning solutions.
