- 11 6-3-203. Cruelty to animals; penalties; limitation on

2	(j) In addition to any sentence and penalties imposed
3	under subsections (e), (h) and (n) of this section, the
4	court may:

6	(i) Require the defendant to <del>pay all reasonable</del>
7	costs incurred in providing necessary food and water,
8	veterinary attention and treatment for any animal affected
9	post a bond with the circuit court in the county where the
10	animal was impounded in accordance with the following;
11	
12	(A) The bond shall be:
13	
14	(I) In an amount the circuit court
15	determines is sufficient to provide for the animal's
16	impoundment, transportation, board, nutritional care,
17	veterinary care and diagnostic testing for at least ninety
18	(90) days including the day on which the animal was
19	impounded. The bond may also include an amount the circuit
20	court determines sufficient to provide for the final
21	disposition of the animal; and

1	(II) Filed with the circuit court
2	within ten (10) days after the animal is impounded.
3	
4	(B) When the bond expires, if the owner of
5	the animal desires to prevent disposition of the animal by
6	a person with authority to enforce this section, the owner
7	shall post a new bond with the court as described in
8	subparagraph (A) of this paragraph.
9	
10	(C) If a bond is not posted under
11	subparagraph (A) or (B) of this paragraph, a person with
12	authority to enforce this section shall dispose of the
13	animal. As used in this paragraph, "dispose" means to sell
14	or destroy the animal. The owner of the animal shall be
15	liable for all costs associated with the final disposition
16	of the animal under this subparagraph.

18	(D) If a bond has been posted in accordance
19	with subparagraph (A) or (B) of this paragraph, the person
20	with authority to enforce this section may draw from the
21	bond the actual costs as described in subdivision (I) of
22	subparagraph (A) of this paragraph, from the date of

4	11-29-114. Impoundment of livestock animals; cost of
5	care for livestock animals; providing for bond.

7	(b) The owner of the livestock animal impounded under
8	subsection (a) of this section, and who has been cited
9	under W.S. 6-3-203, shall be required to post a bond with
10	the circuit court in the county where the livestock animal
11	was impounded. The bond shall be:

13	(i) In an amount the circuit court determines is
14	sufficient to provide for the livestock animal's
15	impoundment, transportation, board, nutritional care,
16	veterinary care and diagnostic testing for at least ninety
17	(90) days including the day on which the livestock animal
18	was impounded; and
