AN ACT relating to emergency expenses of government related to business relief; providing funding for grants to agriculture businesses impacted by COVID-19; providing a reappropriation of federal CARES Act funds; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 **Section 1**. As used in this section, "agriculture 10 business" means a business that is engaged in farming or 11 ranching and produces livestock, feed, produce or other 12 food items normally grown or raised by ranchers or farmers.

The below language reappropriates money from the Governor's CARES Act appropriations to the Wyoming Business Council to extend funding for the Wyoming business interruption stipend program so the additional funding can be used specifically for agriculture businesses.

8 9 Section 2. There is reappropriated to the Wyoming 10 business council eighty million dollars (\$80,000,000.00) from any federal funds appropriated in 2020 Wyoming Special 11 12 Session Laws, Chapter 1, Section 2(b) and as authorized and 13 made available for expenditure in Section 2(c)(ii) 14 Section 2(c)(iii) for the purpose of extending funding for the Wyoming business interruption stipend program to be 15 16 used for grants to agriculture businesses pursuant to the 17 Wyoming business interruption stipend program created by in 2020 Wyoming Special Session Laws, Chapter 3, Section 2(b). 18 If a COVID-19 relief account or other similarly named 19 20 account is created for the deposit of COVID-19 related 21 emergency response funds, this appropriation shall be made 22 from that account. Except as provided in this section, the 23 funds reappropriated under this section shall 24 expended for making the grants authorized by this act and consistent with the terms of the federal gift, grant or 25 26 appropriation from which the funds originate.
