9	licensure or permitting as necessary for the health, safety
10	and welfare of the state during the period of a public
11	health emergency declared by the governor under W.S. 35-4-
12	115(a)(i). After the end of a declared public health
13	emergency, a board shall require a person who has made use
14	of a waiver or modification provided under this subsection
15	to meet all applicable statutory examination and continuing
16	education requirements.
