1 AN ACT relating to the department of transportation; 2 amending leasing provisions for department of 3 transportation communications facilities for the provision of broadband and telecommunications services; specifying 4 lease proceeds 5 disposition of from communications facilities; providing definitions; and providing for an 6 effective date. 7 8

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 24-2-116 is amended to read:

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24-2-116. Department of transportation state-funded
communications facilities.

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4 (a) Upon application by a telecommunications company, if the public service commission determines that it is 5 necessary to provide telecommunications service to 6 7 underserved areas of the state, the Wyoming department of 8 transportation shall lease excess capacity on any statefunded communication infrastructure or facility owned by 9 10 the department of transportation to the telecommunications 11 company. For purposes of this section an area is underserved if private communication providers are 12 unwilling or unable to provide the telecommunication 13 service to a substantial number of households or persons in 14 15 the geographic area. The rate of the lease shall be a not 16 exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the reasonable market-17 based rate as determined by the public service commission or shall be for the provision of in-kind services as 18 19 negotiated by the department. No telecommunications company 20 may lease excess capacity on a state-funded communication 21 infrastructure or facility owned by the department pursuant this section unless the telecommunications company 22 23 establishes that excess capacity in that area is

1 unavailable from private commercial communication facility 2 The public service commission may adopt rules and 3 regulations necessary to implement this section. All 4 monies received from any lease executed pursuant to this 5 section shall be deposited into the state general fund WyoLink tower maintenance account, which is hereby created. 6 Funds in the account are continuously appropriated to the 7 8 department and shall only be used to maintain, reinforce and repair WyoLink towers in Wyoming. 9 10 11 (b) No broadband provider shall lease excess capacity as provided in subsection (a) of this section unless the 12 broadband provider certifies that the lease will result in 13 the provision of broadband internet service with a fixed 14 terrestrial broadband download speed of not less than 15 twenty-five (25) megabits per second and an upload speed of 16 not less than three (3) megabits per second and broadband 17 network round-trip latency of not greater than one hundred 18 19 (100) milliseconds not less than eighty percent (80%) of 20 the time as measured by testing during peak period 21 measurements. 22
