A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of the government;
2 authorizing payment of moving expenses for state officers
3 and employees; and providing for effective dates.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 Section 1. W.S. 9-3-104(a) is amended to read:

9 **9-3-104. Moving expenses.**

11 (a) When any state officer or employee ~~is transferred~~
12 transfers from one (1) official station to another within

1 the state of Wyoming for permanent duty, ~~when the transfer~~
2 ~~is made at the request of and for the benefit of the state~~
3 ~~of Wyoming,~~ the employing agency:

5 (i) Shall pay the actual expenses of
6 transporting the household goods and effects of the officer
7 or employee when the transfer is made as a requirement of
8 employment and for the benefit of the state of Wyoming;

10 (ii) At the discretion of the administrative
11 head of the employing agency, may pay an amount not to
12 exceed the amount allowed by department of administration
13 and information rules for the actual expenses or a portion
14 of the actual expenses of transporting the household goods
15 and effects of the officer or employee when the transfer
16 results from the employing agency's recruitment of the
17 officer or employee to a new official station for
18 employment.

1 **Section 2.** On or before July 1, 2021, the department
2 of administration and information shall promulgate rules
3 under W.S. 9-2-1022 necessary to implement this act.

7 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
8 section, this act is effective July 1, 2021.

10 (b) Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective
11 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a
12 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of
13 the Wyoming Constitution.
