AN ACT relating to the military department; creating a fund for the deposit of monies from grazing fees at military training areas; authorizing the adjutant general to administer the fund and expend monies for range management and grazing operations; requiring annual reports; providing for a continuous appropriation; providing for an appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

11 **Section 1**. W.S. 19-7-209 is created to read:

1	19-7-209. Military department range management
2	operations; account; administration; rulemaking.
3	
4	(a) There is created the military department range
5	management and grazing program. The military department
6	shall administer range management and grazing operations at
7	Camp Guernsey and any other Wyoming national guard training
8	areas that are owned in fee by the military department and
9	that are not state lands as defined in W.S.
10	36-1-101(a)(iv). The military department range management
11	and grazing program shall:
12	
13	(i) Conduct the day to day range management and
14	grazing operations within the training area;
15	
16	(ii) Ensure the safety of customers, users,
17	grazers and property;
18	
19	(iii) Arrange for personnel and materials for
20	the management, installation, construction, maintenance and
21	repair of fencing, vegetation, roads, water storage, fire
22	mitigation and other related facilities and range
23	management activities;

2 (iv) Calculate animal unit grazing usage and

3 needs and determine forage use plans;

5 (v) Manage lessee and neighbor matters;

7 (vi) Conduct required cultural and environmental

8 assessments.

10 (b) The military department range management grazing account is created. Monies received from the range 11 12 management and grazing operations authorized in subsection (a) of this section shall be credited to the account, 13 except as otherwise provided in this subsection. Funds in 14 15 military department range management and the 16 account are continuously appropriated to the military 17 department and shall only be used for purposes of this section. The state treasurer shall invest monies received 18 19 under this paragraph in accordance with law and 20 investment earnings received therefrom shall be deposited 21 into the military department range management operations account. From the monies received from the operations 22 authorized in subsection (a) of this section, any amount in 23

- 1 excess of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) in
- 2 the account at the end of each fiscal biennium shall be
- 3 deposited into the general fund.

- 5 (c) The military department shall promulgate rules to
- 6 administer this section.

7

- 8 (d) The adjutant general shall report annually by
- 9 October 15 to the joint transportation, highways and
- 10 military affairs interim committee regarding all income to
- 11 and expenditures from the military department range
- 12 management operations account.

- 16 (a) The adjutant general is authorized to hire not
- 17 more than three (3) at-will contract employee positions to
- 18 administer the program created in section 1 of this act.
- 19 Funds to pay all costs related to these positions shall be
- 20 available for expenditure only from the military department
- 21 range management and grazing account created in section 1
- 22 of this act, except as provided in this section.

1	(b) There is appropriated \$300,000.00 from the
2	general fund to the military department for purposes of
3	establishing the military department range management
4	program created in section 1 of this act. This
5	appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the
6	effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2022. This
7	appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any
8	other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
9	remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
10	by law on June 30, 2022.
11	
12	Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
13	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
14	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
15	Constitution.
