A JOINT RESOLUTION

for

- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress to enact legislation 2 and requesting that the Veteran's Administration work to
- 3 expand and improve efforts to treat traumatic brain injuries
- 4 and post-traumatic stress disorder.

5

- 6 WHEREAS, national veteran suicide crises data indicates that
- 7 as many as twenty-two (22) veterans commit suicide every day;
- 8 and

9

- 10 WHEREAS, traumatic brain injuries (TBIs) and post-traumatic
- 11 stress disorder (PTSD) can be causes of suicide; and

12

- 1 WHEREAS, data collected from 2000 to 2019 Department of
- 2 Defense numbers for TBI worldwide for Active, Guard and
- 3 Reserve members in the Army, Navy, Air Force and Marines, for
- 4 all severities of TBI, total 413,858 service members; and

5

- 6 WHEREAS, the number of veterans with PTSD varies by service
- 7 era but ranges from about eleven percent (11%) to about thirty
- 8 percent (30%); and

9

- 10 WHEREAS, traumatic brain injuries and post-traumatic stress
- 11 disorder both involve physical injury to brain tissue; and

12

- 13 WHEREAS, current standards of care approved for veterans for
- 14 traumatic brain injuries and post-traumatic stress disorder
- 15 focus on medication and counseling; and

16

- 17 WHEREAS, additional treatments, vocational counseling and
- 18 rehabilitation therapies exist that have been clinically
- 19 proven to mitigate symptoms and improve recovery when used
- 20 alone or integrated with counseling. Additional therapies to
- 21 treat traumatic brain injuries and post-traumatic stress
- 22 disorder include physical therapy, occupational therapy,

- 1 cognitive therapy, speech therapy and hyperbaric oxygen
- 2 therapy; and

3

- 4 WHEREAS, hyperbaric oxygen therapy couples hyperbaric oxygen
- 5 chamber treatment, which promotes oxygen for healing and
- 6 restoring injured brain tissue, together with counseling; and

7

- 8 WHEREAS, access to a variety of treatments improves a
- 9 veteran's opportunities for healing and recovery; and

10

- 11 WHEREAS, the TBI and PTSD Treatment Act (2019 S. 2504/H.R.
- 12 4370) will require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to
- 13 furnish hyperbaric oxygen therapy to a veteran suffering from
- 14 traumatic brain injury or post-traumatic stress disorder.

- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
- 17 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

- 19 **Section 1.** That the Wyoming Legislature requests that
- 20 Congress swiftly enact legislation providing for veterans'
- 21 access to treatments for traumatic brain injury and post-
- 22 traumatic stress disorder that include hyperbaric oxygen
- 23 therapy, such as the TBI and PTSD Treatment Act and any other

- 1 legislation improving or authoring access to other important
- 2 therapies and counseling and legislation fostering research

3 and development of additional therapies.

5 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State of Wyoming

6 transmit copies of this resolution to the Wyoming

7 Congressional Delegation and the Secretary of the United

8 States Department of Veterans Affairs.
