INTRODUCTION**

Selective service registration.

Sponsored by: Joint Transportation, Highways & Military  
Affairs Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to selective service; requiring  
2 certification of selective service registration consent via  
3 driver's license and identification card applications;  
4 requiring the department to transmit data to the selective  
5 service system; conforming provisions; and providing for an  
6 effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-143 is created to read:

11

12 **31-7-143. Selective service registration.**

2 (a) Upon receiving the certification required in  
3 subsection (b) of this section, the department shall  
4 forward electronically or via other means of transmission  
5 to the selective service system the information necessary  
6 from the applicant's Wyoming driver's license or  
7 identification card for the applicant to comply with the  
8 federal Selective Service Act, 50 U.S.C. 3802, et seq.

9

10 (b) An application under W.S. 31-7-111(b) and  
11 31-8-101(a) shall include space for a certification with a  
12 separate signature line and notice to the applicant that  
13 "By my signature I certify that I am consenting to using  
14 information submitted on this application for registration  
15 with the United States Selective Service System if my  
16 registration is required by federal law.";

17

18 (c) The applicant's submission of the application  
19 after signing the certification in subsection (b) of this  
20 section constitutes the applicant's consent to the  
21 transmission of the information in subsection (a) of this  
22 section. The department may accept an application from an  
23 applicant who has not signed an application pursuant to

1 subsection (b) of this section but shall advise the  
2 applicant to contact the selective service system for  
3 alternative options to comply with the federal Selective  
4 Service Act.

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6 (d) Subsections (a) and (c) of this section do not  
7 apply to an applicant for whom the department has  
8 previously transmitted information to comply with the  
9 requirements of the selective service system.

10

11 (e) Nothing in this section shall restrict the  
12 information the department may provide under the federal  
13 Driver's Privacy Protection Act.

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15 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-7-111(b) by creating a new  
16 paragraph (xv) and 31-8-101(b) are amended to read:

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18 **31-7-111. Application for license or permit**  
19 **generally.**

21 (b) The application shall include:

22

23 (xv) Information required by W.S. 31-7-143.

2           **31-8-101. Issuance to residents by department;**  
3 **restrictions; limited to one state-issued credential;**  
4 **digital identification card; definitions; rulemaking.**

5

6           (a) Any Wyoming resident may be issued an  
7 identification card by the department of transportation if  
8 the resident does not possess or surrenders any other  
9 state-issued, REAL ID Act or other applicable federal law  
10 compliant driver's license or identification card. The  
11 application shall state the registrant's full legal name,  
12 social security number, date of birth and any other  
13 identifying data the department may require and shall be  
14 signed and verified by the applicant. The application shall  
15 include information required by W.S. 31-7-143. The  
16 identification card shall at the applicant's request  
17 indicate that the applicant is an anatomical organ donor as  
18 provided by W.S. 35-5-205 or that the applicant has a  
19 medical alert designation as provided for in W.S. 31-7-142.  
20 Before receiving an identification card under this chapter  
21 a person who previously has been licensed or issued an  
22 identification card in this or any other state but who does

1 not have the credential in their possession shall complete  
2 an affidavit of "No License/ID Card in Possession."

3

4 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2021.
