A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to professions and occupations; authorizing  
2 licensure boards and other certifying authorities to waive  
3 examination and continuing education requirements as  
4 specified; providing a sunset date; and providing for an  
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

10

11 (a) For any occupation for which licensure,  
12 certification or other authorization to practice is

1 required by Wyoming law, the relevant licensing or  
2 certifying authority, notwithstanding any provision of its  
3 licensure or certification statutes, may waive any  
4 examination or continuing education requirement if:

5

6 (i) The examination is not being given or is not  
7 practically available due to the COVID-19 pandemic or a  
8 different reason or event; or

9

10 (ii) Continuing education opportunities are not  
11 practically available due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

13 (b) The relevant licensing or certifying authority  
14 may impose reasonable or necessary restrictions or  
15 requirements on a license, certification or practice  
16 authority affected by a waiver obtained pursuant to this  
17 section.

18

19 (c) This section is repealed effective July 1, 2021.

20

21 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
22 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

1 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
2 Constitution.
