3	
4	This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the
5	"Wyoming Decentralized Autonomous Organization Supplement."
6	
7	17-XX-102. Definitions.
8	
9	(a) As used in this supplement:

L1	(i) "Blockchain" means a digital ledger or
L2	database, as defined in W.S. 34-29-106, which is
L3	chronological, consensus-based, decentralized and
L 4	mathematically verified in nature.

L6	(ii) "Decentralized Autonomous Organization"
L7	means a limited liability company organized under this
L8	Supplement.

20	(iii) "Majority vote," unless the underlying
21	smart contracts or operating agreement provide otherwise,

means more than fifty percent (50%) of its membership

1 interests as defined in the underlying smart contract or 2 operating agreement.

4 (iv) "Smart contract" means an automated 5 transaction, as defined in W.S. 40-21-102(a)(ii), or any 6 substantially similar analogue, which is comprised of code, 7 script or programming language that executes the terms of 8 an agreement, and which may include taking custody of and 9 transferring an asset, or issuing executable instructions 10 for these actions, based on the occurrence or nonoccurrence 11 of specified conditions.

13 17-XX-103. Application of Wyoming Limited Liability
14 Company Act.

15

16 (a) The Wyoming Limited Liability Company Act applies 17 to Decentralized Autonomous Organizations to the extent not 18 inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter and the 19 powers provided the secretary of state by W.S. 17-29-1102 20 shall apply to this supplement.

21

(b) This chapter does not repeal or modify any statute or rule of law that is or would apply to a limited

- 1 liability company that is organized under the Wyoming
- 2 Limited Liability Company Act that does not elect to become
- 3 a decentralized autonomous organization.

- 5 17-XX-104. Definition and election of Decentralized
- 6 Autonomous Organization status.

- 8 (a) A Decentralized Autonomous Organization is a
- 9 limited liability company whose articles of organization
- 10 contain a statement that the company is a decentralized
- 11 autonomous organization.

- 13 (b) A limited liability company formed under W.S. 17-
- 14 29-101 through 17-29-1102 may convert to a decentralized
- 15 autonomous organization by amending its articles of
- 16 organization to include the statement required by
- 17 subsection (a) of this section and W.S. § 17-XX-105.

- 19 (c) A statement in substantially the following form
- 20 shall appear conspicuously in the articles of organization
- 21 or operating agreement, if applicable, in a decentralized
- 22 autonomous organization:

1	NOTICE OF RESTRICTIONS ON DUTIES AND TRANSFERS

3	The rights of members in a decentralized autonomous
4	organization may differ materially from the rights of
5	members in other limited liability companies. The
6	decentralized autonomous organization Supplement,
7	underlying smart contracts, articles of organization, and
8	operating agreement, if applicable, of a decentralized
9	autonomous organization may define, reduce, or eliminate
10	fiduciary duties and may restrict transfer ownership
11	interests, withdrawal or resignation from the decentralized
12	autonomous organization, return of capital contributions,
13	and dissolution of the decentralized autonomous
14	organization.

16	(d) The registered name for a decentralized autonomous
17	organization shall include wording or abbreviation to
18	denote its status as a decentralized autonomous
19	organization, specifically "DAO," "LAO", or "DAO LLC."

21	(e) A statement in the articles of organization may

23	a member-managed Decentralized Autonomous Organization or

- 9 (a) Any person may form a Decentralized Autonomous
- 10 which shall have one (1) or more members by signing and
- 11 delivering one (1) original and one (1) exact or conformed
- 12 copy of the articles of organization to the secretary of
- 13 state for filing. The person forming the decentralized
- 14 autonomous organization need not be a member of the
- 15 company.

16

- 17 (b) Each decentralized autonomous organization shall
- 18 have and continuously maintain in this state A registered
- 19 agent as provided in W.S. 17-28-101 through 17-28-111.

21 17-XX-106. Articles of organization.

1 (a) The articles of organization of a decentralized 2 autonomous organization shall include a statement that the 3 company is a decentralized autonomous organization and 4 shall set forth the matters required by Wyo. Stat. § 17-29-201. 5 6 7 (b) The articles of organization shall include a 8 publicly available identifier of any smart contract directly used to manage, facilitate, or operate the 9 10 decentralized autonomous organization. 11 12 (c) Except as otherwise provided in this supplement, the articles of organization and smart contracts shall 13 govern all of the following: 14 15 16 (i) Relations among the members as members and 17 between the members and the decentralized autonomous 18 organization; 19 20 (ii) The rights and duties under this chapter of 21 a person in the capacity as a member;

1	(111) The activities of the decentralized
2	autonomous organization and the conduct of those

2	Articles of organization shall be amended when:

5	liability company;

7	(ii) There is a false or erroneous statement in
8	the articles of organization; or

10	(iii) The decentralized autonomous organization's
11	smart contracts have been updated or changed.

13	17-XX-108. Operating Agreement.
14	
15	To the extent the articles of organization or smart
16	contract does not otherwise provide for a matter described
17	in Wyo. Stat. § $17-XX-106$, the operation of a DAO may be
18	supplemented by an operating agreement.
19	
20	17-XX-109. Management.
21	
22	Management of a decentralized autonomous organization shall
23	be vested in its members, if a member-managed, or the smart

- 1 contract, if algorithmically managed, unless otherwise
- 2 provided in the articles of organization or operating
- 3 agreement.

- 5 17-XX-110. Standards of conduct for members and
- 6 managers.

- 8 Unless otherwise provided for in the articles of
- 9 organization or operating agreement, no member of a
- 10 decentralized autonomous organizations shall have any
- 11 fiduciary duty to the company or any member except that the
- 12 members shall be subject to the implied contractual
- 13 covenant of good faith and fair dealing.

- 15 17-XX-111. Right of members, managers and dissociated
- 16 members to information.

- 18 Members shall have no right under Wyo. Stat. § 17-29-410 to
- 19 inspect or copy records of the decentralized autonomous
- 20 organization and the organization shall have no obligation
- 21 to furnish any information concerning the organization's
- 22 activities, financial condition, or other circumstances if
- 23 that information is available on an open blockchain.

2 17-XX-112. Withdrawal of members.

4 (a) A member may only withdraw from a decentralized sutonomous organization upon the terms and in accordance with the terms set forth in the articles of organizations, the smart contracts, and, if applicable, the operating sqreement. If no terms and conditions for withdrawal are set forth for a member-managed decentralized autonomous organization, a member may withdraw only with the consent

13 (b) A member of a decentralized autonomous 14 organization may not have the company dissolved for a 15 failure to return his or its contribution to capital.

17 **17-XX-113.** Dissolution.

of a majority vote of members.

19 (a) A decentralized autonomous organization organized 20 under this chapter shall be dissolved upon the occurrence 21 of any of the following events:

Τ	(1) when the period fixed for the duration of the
2	company expires;

4	(ii) By the majority vote of all members; or
5	
6	(iii) At the time or upon the occurrence of
7	events specified in the underlying smart contracts, or
8	failing that, as specified in the articles of incorporation
9	or operating agreement.
10	
11	(b) As soon as possible following the occurrence of
12	any of the events specified in subsection (a) of this
13	section causing the dissolution of a decentralized
14	autonomous organization, the company shall execute a
15	statement of intent to dissolve in the form prescribed by
16	the secretary of state.
17	
18	17-XX-114. Miscellaneous.
19	
20	The articles or organization and the operating agreement of
21	a decentralized autonomous organization are effective as
22	statements of authority. Where the underlying articles of
23	organization and operating agreement are in conflict, the

1 articles of organization will preempt any conflicting

2 provisions. Where the underlying articles of organization

3 and smart contract are in conflict, the smart contract will

4 preempt any conflicting provisions of the articles of

5 organization.
