Overview

The Wyoming Community Colleges provide widely varying academic programs across the state. The following document provides information about the programs offered, how new programs are proposed, approved, and reviewed, and a high-level survey of how and why academic offerings vary from college to college.

Program Approval Process

Once a new academic program is proposed, it must first be approved within the college governance structure, and then forwarded to the Wyoming Community College Commission (WCCC). The WCCC is granted authority to approve new academic programs at the colleges through W.S. 21-18-202(d), and WCCC Rules 6.2 establishes the criteria for approval, which include:

- The alignment of the program with the WY Community College Commission Statewide Strategic Plan
- Projected labor market demand for graduates in the state and region which include a fiveyear period from the proposed implementation date
- Wage projections for program graduates who enter an occupation directly related to their earned academic credential
- Documented citizen, business and industry input in program design and assessment (for AAS or certificates)
- A list of similar programs at other Wyoming community colleges

The WCCC uses a four-tiered approval process to evaluate proposed academic programs according to the criteria listed above. This process includes the following groups:

- 1. Program Review Committee a committee within the Commission that ensures the application is complete, accurate, and meets minimum Commission requirements
- 2. Academic Affairs Council (AAC)—a committee comprised of the VPAA's from each college and facilitated by the Chief Academic Officer for the WCCC. They review the application and ensure that the program is responsive to local and state economic needs.
- 3. Executive Council (EC) a committee comprised of the seven community college presidents and facilitated by the WCCC Executive Director. The EC reviews program approvals from the AAC and approves their addition to Commission agendas.
- 4. Commissioners the appointed Commissioners provide final approval for new programs and ensure that each program meets the criteria established in WCCC statutes and rules.

Review and Termination

The WCCC and the colleges both have processes in place to review existing programs and identify programs that are inefficient, ineffective, or no longer serve the needs of the community.

The WCCC is mandated to review all credit-bearing programs at least once every five years. These reviews compile information on credit hour enrollment, declared major count, program graduates, service area resident program graduates, and state-wide resident program graduates. An executive overview of the program review is compiled and is provided to the colleges, the Legislature, and the general public.

Each college maintains its own process to consistently review program outcomes to ensure programs are effective, efficient, and address the needs of their community. These processes frequently include data from the WCCC program reviews, as well as institutional data, feedback from local industry, and surveys from graduates.

The decision to discontinue a program lies with the college and its governance structure. The colleges have economic, academic, and budgetary motivations to eliminate ineffective programs, and regularly terminate multiple programs each year to ensure their institutional efficiency.

Academic Offerings

Types of Credentials: The community colleges offer Associate degrees, Applied Associate degrees, Bachelor of Applied Science degrees, and Certificates.

For the most part, Associate degrees (e.g. Associate of Arts, Associate of Nursing, Associate of Fine Arts, etc.) are designed for students planning to transfer to a 4-year institution, and easily

facilitate transfer into Bachelor degree programs. Amongst full-time students, 2/3's are pursuing transfer-oriented degrees, approximately 75% of all UW graduates transferred from a Wyoming community college.

Certificates, Applied Associates and Bachelor of Applied Science programs are commonly called "Terminal Degrees" insofar as they represent the final educational credential before a student enters the workforce. It is important to note that our modern economy increasingly requires frequent up-skilling and retraining as jobs change and required skillsets expand and develop. Within this environment, the concept of "Terminal Degrees" becomes less accurate, and many workers who obtain such a degree or certificate will pursue additional credentials later in life. The percentage of community college students pursuing these types of credentials is growing, as is the percentage of students who are working adults. To this point, 63% of part-time students (most working adults cannot attend college full-time) are pursuing CTE or Certificate programs.

Scope of Academic Offerings:

The community colleges currently offer 751 academic programs (degrees or certificates). A complete list of currently approved programs can be found in **Appendix A**.

Replication vs. Duplication: While 751 programs may seem like a large number given Wyoming's small population, it is important to note the difference between Replication and Duplication.

Replicating effective and high-demand programs at different institutions allows students from different regions of Wyoming to take advantage of similar programs. Examples would include multiple welding or business administration programs across the colleges. Welding and business are both fields with high demand across the state, and the establishment of multiple programs prevents bottlenecks and ensures that all regions have access to a workforce with these vital skills.

Duplication refers to creating a copy of an existing program and introducing it to a new region regardless of need or demand. This can lead to start-up costs with minimal enrollment, or unnecessary competition across colleges for limited numbers of interested students.

The approval process specifically requests information on existing, similar programs across the state and requires an explanation of how the new program is not duplication. Furthermore, the WCCC 5-year review process and internal college review processes review enrollment and cost numbers and have been effective in addressing unintended instances of duplication.

Regional Specialization: The program listing in **Appendix A** also reveals the extent to which colleges adopt academic programs that uniquely address the needs of their local communities and regions. See below for a listing of the top 12 programs by enrollment at each of the colleges. Note that while some programs are consistent across the state (e.g. A.A. General Studies, Associate of Nursing, etc.) there is also significant variety reflective of the unique needs of each region.

Consortium and Partnerships: In an effort to increase program efficiency—particularly for fields with high capital costs—the colleges are increasingly looking to consortium or state-wide partnership approaches. The ReNEW program was one of the first cooperative academic initiatives, allowing for students to pursue nursing while reducing costs and travel for their first two years by studying at a community college before transferring to UW to complete their degree. While the logistics of these types of programs varies, they all allow the colleges to leverage multiple institutional resources to provide additional student opportunities. Additional examples include:

- CDL Certification across LCCC, EWC and NWC
- Dental Hygiene NWCCD and UW
- Medical Laboratory Tech Casper and UW
- CTE Teacher Education Program UW and all 7 colleges

While these programs represent positive progress towards more efficiency and partnership, it should be noted that current funding models frequently create disincentives to partner programs. State allocations are assigned, in part, by each institution's FTE, and therefore a college's participation in a consortium with two other colleges brings in less state funding than if that same program was offered solely by that same college.
